Edexcel (formerly known as University of London Examinations and currently rechristened as Pearson) has adopted the following grading system for their examinations.

AS and A Level Examinations:

The summation of AS Level (class 11) marks in each subject is given with a prefix X followed by the subject code and summation of A level (class 12) marks for each subject with a prefix Y followed by the subject code. Students intending to join Indian Universities can obtain numerical conversion for letter grades from their respective schools. For purposes of admission in higher education in Indian colleges/universities one can take the UMS marks or where only grades are given by certain countries they can be guided by the following table:

- School admission in class 11 is based on International GCSE or GCSE results
 - As per AIU Information Brochure para 40 (d) - Minimum 5 subjects including English with minimum grades A to E (grades 3,4,5,6,7,8 and 9 under 9-1 grading system) - subject to a minimum of 35% in each subject
- College/University admission based on A Level examinations of Edexcel (Pearson) Board Examinations such as GCE or International Advanced Levels (IAL) - as per AIU Information Brochure para 40 (d) - Minimum Grades A to E in subjects- Subject to a minimum of 35% in each subject with
 - English at AS Level(equivalent of Class 11)
 - Two subjects for Science and Commerce courses at A Level (equivalent of Class 12)
 - Three subjects at A Level (equivalent of Class 12)
 - Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry for Engineering Courses
 - Biology, Physics and Chemistry for Medical Courses
 - Subject to other requirements as prescribed by the respective Councils/ Universities

Colleges/Universities can permit combination of subjects from GCE and/or IAL for admission purposes
